Mermaid Moon by Colleen Coble_(suspense)

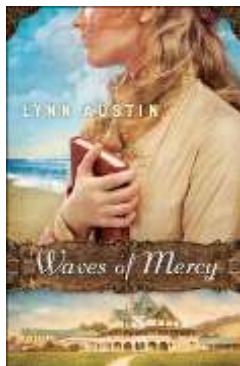
Monday, June 12 - Sanctuary Parlor – 10:00-11:30 am
